

## GRAMOPHONE GOIDEN TONES REVIDED

Masters (and a mistress) of the violin

Not long after the war's end and the terrible revelations that followed, at least two great Jewish violinists performed in Germany, including Menuhin whose slightly shaky 1949 Tchaikovsky Concerto under Ferenc Fricsay has just reappeared on Audite coupled with an often radiant Mozart K218 (Karl Böhm, 1951) and an unusually intense Bach Chaconne from 1948.
